Honourable the Lord Proprietary by and with the Consent of the upper and lower house of this present Generall Assembly that all persons whosoever that are cast in any cause be they plaintiff or Defendant shall be amerced beside the damage and cost to the recoverours) fifty pounds of Tobacco in the Provinciaall Court to be employed as the Governour and Council shall think And in the County Courts thirty pounds of Tobacco to be employed as the Commissioners shall think fitt for the due collecting whereof be it enacted By the authority aforesaid that the Clerk of the Provinciaall Court and the Clerks of all County Courts keep an exact accompt of the Amerciements and deliver or send the same to the severall Sherifes of the perticular Counties who are hereby required to collect the same with the Seawyes and are accordingly impowred for default of payment to make distresse and commanded not to return any arrears Executors and Administrators who cannot pay without orders allwayes excepted And be it further enacted that the Clerks of the respective Courts shall give unto the Chief Judge of every Court a list of the Amerciements that Court imposed this Act to continue for three years or to the next Generall Assembly
